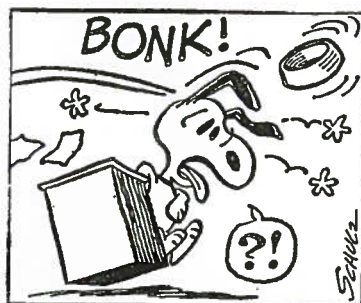

VOLLEYBALL

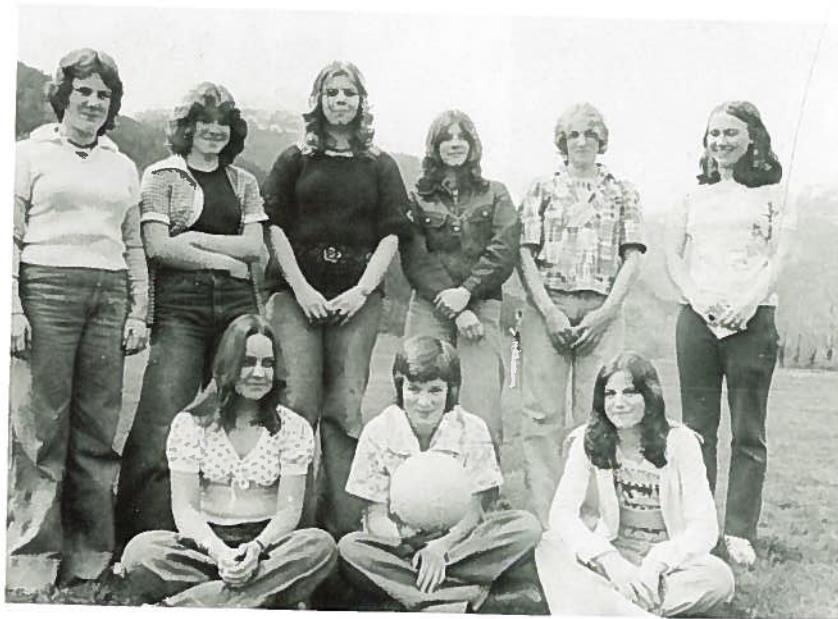

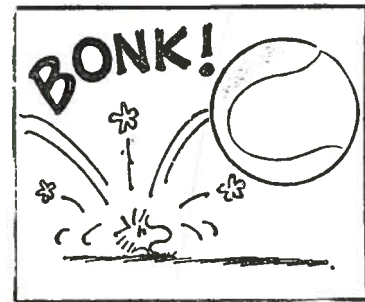

BASKETBALL

This year, once again the mighty Red Devils actively participated in basketball competition. All the teams practiced hard and regularly under the watchful eyes of our many dedicated coaches.

The Senior Boys had a pretty good season, winning approximately 15 of 27 games. The team played in many tournaments, often going up against stiff competition. In Princeton they placed 5th, 4th at University Hill, 3rd at the Mile-O, 2nd at St. Pat's, 2nd at the Howe Sound Playoffs and 1st at the C.T.C. tournament. Brian Wray won all stars at all of the tournaments, including M.V.P. at University Hill and the C.T.C. Gary Wray received all stars in the C.T.V. and Howe Sound Playoffs, while Ken Fraser won M.V.P. at the Howe Sound Playoffs. The team managed to pile up 600 plus foul points, for the season. 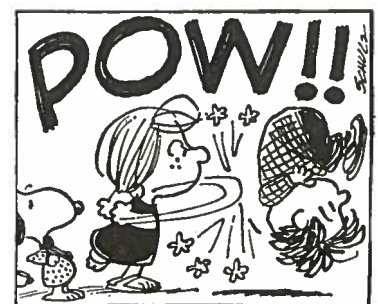

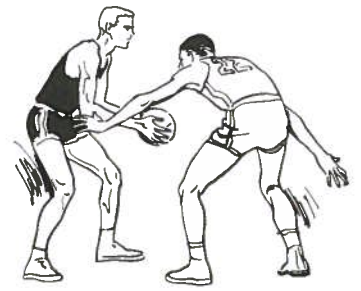

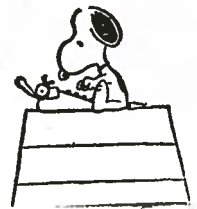
