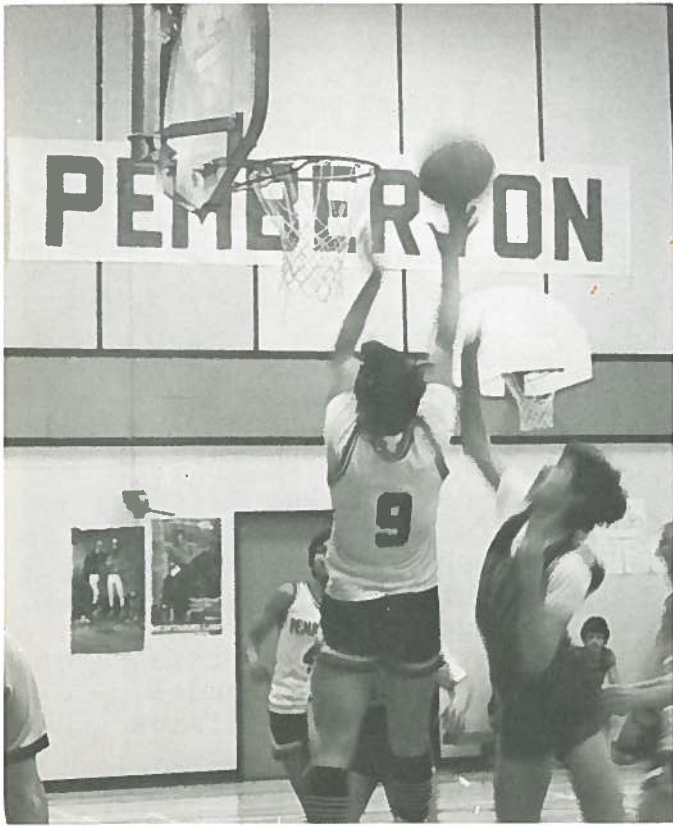

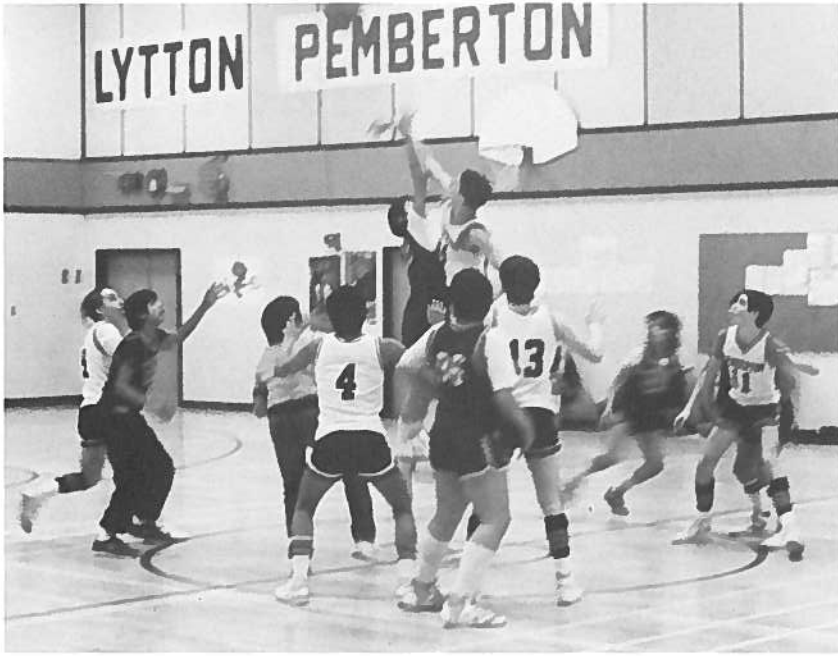
# Volleyball

### DOWNHILL SKI TEAM

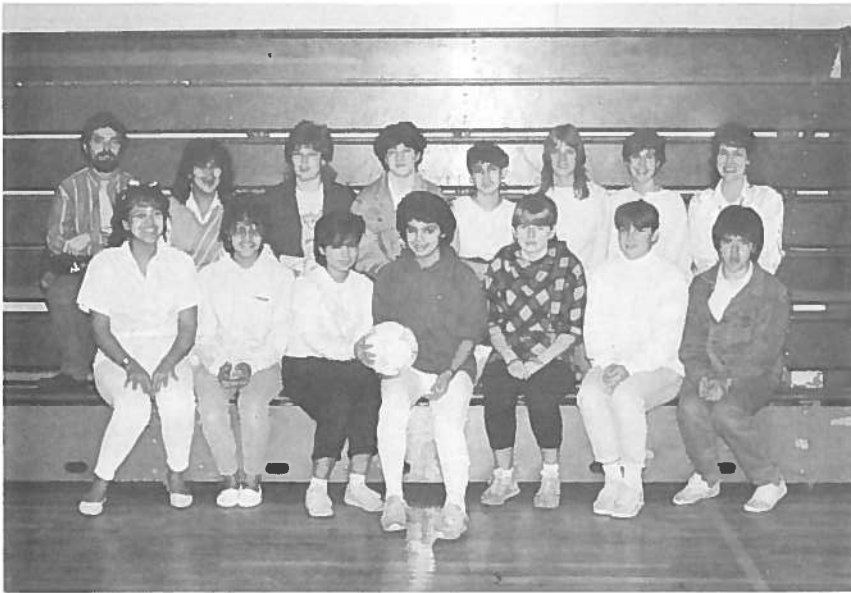
